# A B C'S OF FAITH

Admit today that you cannot do life on your own and that you need help. The one who can make sense of it all and fit all the pieces of the puzzle that are a jumble in your life - His name is Jesus. He came to give you help, hope, and a home.

**Believe** that He erased the sin and wrong you have done by dying on the cross for you and that he rose to life to show His power over sin and death. Trusting in God to rescue you is of the utmost importance.

Confess him as your Savior and Lord. There's no magic formula. In your own words you can say something like, "Jesus I'm tired of trying to make life work on my own. I believe you died for me on the cross and that you are alive today. Forgive me for my sins — all the things I've done wrong. Jesus, I invite you to be the Savior, and the Lord of my life. I commit to doing life your way instead of my way. In Jesus' Name Amen."
